TECHNICAL:

APPLICATION OF THE HAIR SYSTEM

Sectioning for First Extension

Tilt head up finding crease. Place first extension above.

Using a tail comb, part across the back of the head just above the occipital area, from ear to ear. Secure the excess hair above the parting with clips.

Placing First Extension

Take extension and place in just under the part and using a grease pencil, mark where the extension begins and ends. Technical Tip: Your placement should start approximately one inch from hairline on each side.

Take **Red Setup Pro Tape** and place on the back of your thumb nail. Draw back the red protective layer away from the bonding strip. Cut ½" of bonding strip away to give you better ability to remove the **Red Setup Pro Tape** once attached to hair.

Lay the **Red Setup Pro Tape** slightly below the parting. Work along parting to opposite side. Keep taut, but do not stretch.

Press with thumbs firmly from the center out to both sides securing bonding strip to eliminate any gaps. Press **Red Protective Layer** with comb, teeth up, hold for a few seconds to secure to growing hair.

With the **White Protective Layer** remaining on polymer base weft, measure and cut the width needed to match the **Red Setup Pro Tape** on growing hair of the client.

Cut the width of extension weft to match size needed on head for each section separately.

Cut the Extension and Bonding Strip at an angle to help avoid corners lifting from brushing. The Bonding strip and the weft each need to be cut at a 45 degree angle toward the center. **See Diagram below - Are we using?**

Remove the **Red Protective Layer** from bonding strip on growing hair. Using your application hook, gently pull down small strands of your client's hair from above the parting and lay it on top of the **Red Tape**. Each section of hair strands should be approximately 1/8" to 1/4" inch apart.

Press hair to bonding strips with back of application hook. Do not use fingers!

Take 1/4" of growing hair and draw over the top corner of the bonding strip to prevent early lifting of corners due to brushing. Leave lower corner of bonding strip free of hair to make a strong tape-on-tape cross link.

Now peel away the protective surface of your **White Tape** and begin to align and apply our extension to the bonding strip on growing hair. Starting at the left side out edge, join these 2 points together by using your thumb or index finger and firmly pressing in place. Keeping tension on your Extension, simply continue applying from left to right and pressing in place. While applying, you will need to make sure your Extension lies flat against the head.

Press with comb to secure the bonding strips on extension weft to cross link extension with bonding strip on growing hair.

Extension should be flat and secure to client's head.

Applying Skin Protectant to Client's Scalp

Apply a protectant to create a barrier between the hair system and the client's scalp to protect the skin. When applying protectant make sure to remove 75% of the grease pencil markings. Before proceeding make sure the protectant has dried into the hair and scalp. **Where does this paragraph go?**

Applying First Strip of Tape

First create a pull tab by placing the end of the **white tape** roll on your thumb nail. Peel the backing away and cut about 1/2 in pull tab. Technical Tip: Apply tape just behind your first marking and just below your parting. Work the tape to the opposite side, keeping the tape taut, but do not stretch. Cut the opposite end using your tape shears. Eliminate any gaps in the tape by using your thumbs and press from the center of the tape to opposing ends securing bonding strip to eliminate any gaps.

Create a Veil

Remove backing of adhesive strip from the tape on growing hair. Using a tail comb gently pull a slight veil of hair from above the parting and lay it on top of the exposed tape. Technical Tip: Place euro tab on top of veil at corners for extra security.

Applying Extension

Peel away the adhesive strip backing from the extension and align the extension with the tape that is already on the client's scalp. Join the extension together using your thumb and index finger and firmly pressing in place. Keeping tension on your extension continue applying and pressing into place, making sure that the extension is lying flat to the head.

Securing Corners

Using a tail comb, make a small backwards "c" shape around the corner of the extension. Direct this hair diagonally back and apply a small amount of the soft bond and cure using a blow dryer on a cool setting.

Final Press

Using a hard rubber comb, secure attachment by pressing entire extension with comb. This will remove any air bubbles that may have been trapped.

Applying Additional Lines

Continue steps 7-14 for each additional line of extension you are placing on a client. Or repeat these steps if you prefer to ribbon extensions sheets.
