TYPES OF TAPE

We know what types of tape **not** to use on our clients, but choosing the right type of tape to use in different situations can be a little overwhelming, as there are many kinds out there. What is good for one situation may not be the best for another.

Grades of Tape – Industrial, Adhesive, Medical

- Non acrylic - [Selections: White Liner]
 - Good for use on skin
- Acrylic - [Selections: Red Liner]
 - Not acceptable to use on skin
- Suspended adhesive (has no shine because there is no film in tape; no backing) - [Selections: No Shine Tape, Matte Tape]
 - Can break down if client gets too hot or is too active or oily
- Cloth - [Selections: Brown Liner]
 - Very strong, not sheer

Removal of Adhesive

- 99% alcohol
- Oil base
- Uni-Solve – not ideal for cleaning, unless skin is too sensitive to use alcohol
